Rabies is spread to horses by bites from rabid wild animals and pets.

Rabies will kill your horse and you may also be in danger.

Rabies is preventable by vaccinating your horse each year.

Rabies Symptoms in Horses may include:

- Excited behavior- biting viciously
- Drowsiness and paralysis
- Drooping eyelids, flaccid lips, drooling
- Signs of colic and restless pacing

Avoid Exposure:

Call your Veterinarian to examine and treat sick horses.

Vaccinate your horses, dogs and cats for Rabies!
